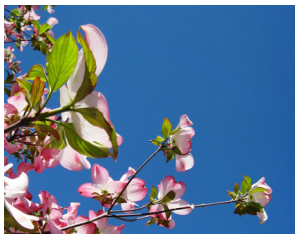
Well, we get a rest, because it's the Holidays. We're keeping a low profile just to surprise you when Spring arrives.
